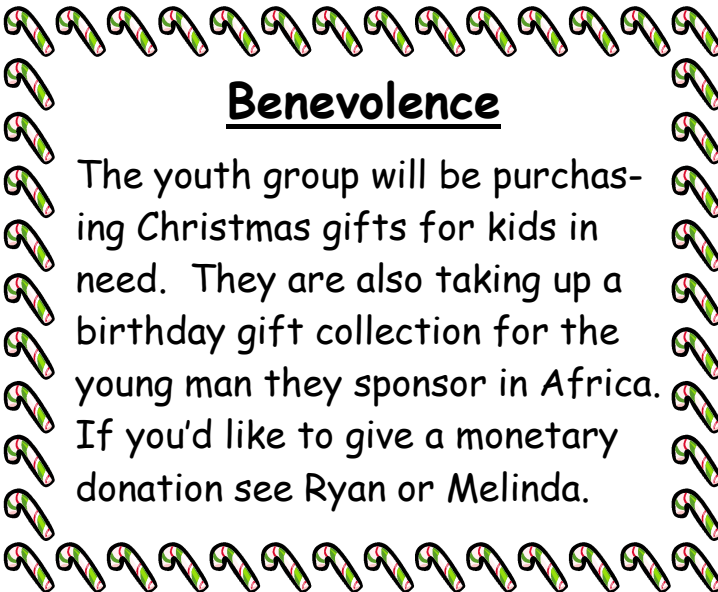
Due to the Thanksgiving holiday no Bible classes will be held, and no meal will be served that night.

Benevolence

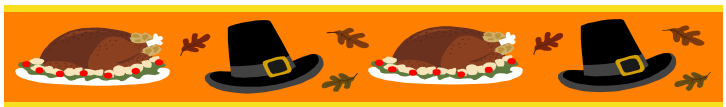
